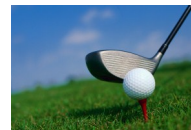

What's the Rule?

Question of the month submitted by Brent Godshall.

"What is the USGA ruling concerning the rocks at Regent Park on holes #1, 3, 6, 10?"

The rocks on these holes should be played as an Immoveable obstruction and proceed with relief under Rule 24-2b. Relief is afforded of 1 club length for interference of stance or intended area of players swing. There is no line of flight relief. You may drop within one club length at your nearest point of relief no nearer the hole. This would be added here as a local rule, other courses may decide not to use this rule. In situations where rocks are in the hazard, the rocks are part of the hazard and no relief will be afforded.
